College Profile

Govt. College Kharkhara Rewari was established by Shri Bhupender Singh Hooda ,(the then Chief Minister of Haryana) in July 2011 as a co-educational Institution to cater the needs of this rural area. It is located on NH-8 Road, approx 18kms from the District Headquarter Rewari and is spread across 8.5 acres of area stretching along the border area of Kharkhara village.

The college Campus has beautiful ambience, lush green and beautiful lawns, modern infrastructural facility which offers a vibrant environment to the students to indulge in extra-curricular activities with holistic approach to achieve sustainable growth of the institution. It nurtures and creates future talent among the students of this region. Its diverse and vibrant atmosphere encourages collaborative learning and stimulates intellectual curiosity.

The college has been affiliated with Indira Gandhi University, Meerpur, Rewari since 2017. It currently offers undergraduate courses in B.A., B.Com., and B.Sc. (Non-Medical), along with two newly introduced postgraduate programs that commenced in the 2024–25 academic session. At present, the college has an enrollment of 1,126 students, primarily from nearby areas such as Rewari, Dungerpur, Masani, Tataepur, Nikhari, Dharuhera, Kapriwas, Malpura, Kharakhara, Bansroad, and others. Additionally, a significant number of students from Bhiwadi—a border town in Rajasthan—have also taken admission.

The college boasts a well-developed infrastructure and a range of modern facilities. These include smart classrooms, LT room, a multipurpose hall, a modern seminar hall, and fully equipped laboratories for Mathematics, Geography, Chemistry, and Physics, along with three computer labs. During the current session, the college also received a grant for the development of a girls' common room and a staff room. Both these spaces are now fully furnished and air-conditioned, ensuring greater comfort for female students and staff members.

College Staff

In the annual report, I commend our dedicated college staff for their unwavering commitment, innovative contributions, and tireless efforts. Their exemplary professionalism, collaborative spirit, and passion for education has been instrumental in shaping a vibrant and successful academic year. There are 13 regular Assistant/Associate Professors, 09 eligible extension lecturers, and 01 computer instructor, 01 clerk, 02 Peon on regular basis, 01 LA, 01 Lab Assistant, 01 Peon, 03 chowkidar, and 01 Mali (Under HKRN Scheme).

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):

The college has constituted an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) with the Principal serving as the Chairperson, along with four senior faculty members from the staff. In accordance with UGC norms and NAAC guidelines, the cell also includes two external members: Mrs. Anuradha, HR Manager, and Mrs. Sushila Yadav, Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat, Kharkhara. Additionally, one student representative, Mr. Manwar from B.A. 2nd year, is also a part of the IQAC.

The IQAC actively undertakes initiatives aimed at the overall development and quality enhancement of the institution. A major achievement of the session was the initiation of the **NAAC Accreditation process**. The IQAC successfully prepared and submitted the Self-Study Report (SSR) in accordance with NAAC guidelines.

In December 2024, the NAAC Peer Team visited the college for inspection. Following a comprehensive evaluation, the college was awarded **Grade B**, and the official NAAC certificate was received in February 2025.

During the session 2024-25 Government College Kharkhara, in collaboration with Government College for Girls, Sector 52, Gurugram, and Government College Rithoj, successfully organized a 1st Two-Day International Conference on Advancing NEP 2020. The conference focused on International Higher Studies, Entrepreneurship, and Mental Resilience and aimed to foster discussions on the transformative impact of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 in shaping the future of higher education in India. The event was conducted in hybrid mode, with 180 participants joining both online and offline. The conference commenced with an inaugural session graced by the Vice Chancellor of IGU Meerpur, Dr. J.P. Yadav. The two-day event featured

insightful keynote addresses, panel discussions, and interactive sessions with eminent academicians and experts.

Dr. Anita Dua, Professor, Biochemistry (Kurukshetra University) was the Key note speaker and highlighted the role of teachers in the effective execution of NEP 2020 and emphasized pedagogical transformations to align with global education standards. The conference concluded with a valedictory address by Dr. Ashok Diwakar, a renowned educationist.

College Library

The college library stands as a haven of knowledge, serving as a vital pillar of our academic community. During the academic session, it was relocated to a more spacious area, offering increased seating capacity. The new facility was inaugurated on 29th September 2023 by Sh. Vinay Kumar, Retired Principal, H.E.S. I.

Our library is now fully air-conditioned and well-equipped, housing approximately 5,200 books covering all subjects offered at the college. With seating available for around 150 students at a time, the library offers ample space for study and reflection. Beyond its academic utility, the library is aesthetically appealing—well-ventilated with multiple windows, brightly lit, clean, and orderly, creating a positive and focused environment for learning and exam preparation.

It is fully automated using SOUL software and provides computer and printing facilities to meet students' academic needs. Students can borrow books, newspapers, and magazines, and the library also includes a dedicated reading section for faculty members.

To assist students in locating resources, a help desk is available. The library subscribes to the Department of Higher Education's digital portal, E-Granthkosh, and the National Digital Library of India (NDLI)—both accessible at no cost. The library is efficiently managed under the supervision of Mrs. Manya Bhola, the Library In-charge, and Sh. Khushiram (Library Assistant), ensuring its smooth and effective operation.

College Website

The college has its own website which is an indispensable hub of information, exudes sophistication and user-friendliness. The content about the college staff, library, courses, syllabi, admissions, scholarships, latest news and events and interactive features is regularly updated and it enhances engagement, reflecting the institution's commitment to transparency and modernity. Sports

The college sports activities are dynamic and invigorating, fostering a spirit of teamwork, discipline, and athleticism. The students since the inception of the college have been consistently performing well since the inception of the college in different events like kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Cricket, Volely Ball, Football, Wrestling, Taekwaondo, wushu etc. The college organised 11th Annual Athletic Meet on 31st oct. 2023 and Dr. Satyamanyu , Principal, Govt. college Gurawara graced this event on the opening ceremony with our Principal, Smt. Archana Soota In this event many students participated in race, throws and jumps etc. The students also participated at various levels like inter college, National, State level throughout the year.

Cultural

College cultural activities are vibrant, fostering creativity and unity among students. These dynamic events showcase diverse talents, promoting a lively, inclusive atmosphere that enriches the academic experience. Dr. Bharat Bhushan, Assistant Professor of Computer Science and Mrs. Manya Bholia Assistant Professor of English are incharges of this committee. During the current session i.e. 2023-24 college students participated in various cultural events at college level and inter college level. The spirit of the event was maintained with a great discipline and enthusiasm Our college students (of various streams) participated with full Zeal and performed at various esteemed platforms. Every opportunity was taken as a challenge and our students transformed it in a big achievement.

- Initially, it was a big task to find the talent of new comers in the various fields of cultural events. For this the college provided platform to students, two days “Talent Hunt” program

was designed and executed. On the first day there were events of fine arts i.e. Rangoli, Slogan writing, Collage, Mehndi, Poster making, Photography etc. On the second day, events of dance, music, literary, theater were organized and performed. A good number of students participated in this event and the duty of judgment was performed minutely by the expert staff member of the college. This event was successful in term to finding the talent and churning it for the upcoming events.

- The very first inter college event that our college participated in was ‘Kalanjali’ and it was organised by Govt. College Pataudi. Seven students participated in this Inter college - inter district cultural fest. Our students participated in Slogan writing, Rangoli, Folk dance (M) & (F), Poetic recitation (Hindi), Poster Making and singing. A new experimental dance pattern was introduced by our student in the category “Folk dance male” i.e fusion of Haryanvi dance with Break Dance. This experiment was highly appreciated by the Judges and the audience. Basically, it was the combination of two different and opposite types of dance pattern i.e. Local Folk along with Western style. **Our college got 2nd position in this event and in slogan writing, poetic recitation and singing.**
- The next event was Youth Festival “Hindola 3.0” organized by IGU Meerpur, from 6-8 Nov at the University Campus. In three days cultural fest, more then 40 colleges, affiliated to IGU, participated in this. Our college participated in 39 events and all the events were presented nicely, with a great spirit of competition. Our College won second prize in Photography.
- At college level, Diwali fest was organized on 9 Nov 2023 at college library. It was an event to enjoy and celebrate our rich esteemed rituals. Beautiful rangoli designs prepared and diyas were lit by all the teaching and non-teaching staff members. The college celebrated this event under the vision direction and guidance of our college principal Smt. Archana Soota ji.
- In the month of Nov 2023, District Administration organized “District Youth Festival – 2023” at IGU Meerpur. Fabulous presentation was given by our college participants in various events.

NSS

The Boys & Girls NSS Units of Govt. College Kharkhara, Rewari actively conducted a variety of meaningful and impactful activities throughout the academic year 2024–2025. The programs focused on national pride, environmental conservation, social service, health awareness, and personal development, in alignment with the NSS motto: “Not Me, But You.”

1. Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign (10th – 15th August 2024)

In celebration of India’s Independence Day, the volunteers of both NSS units participated in the Har Ghar Tiranga Abhiyan, an initiative by Govt. Of India, by encouraging all students and volunteers to hoist the tricolor. Furthermore, a two-day Self-Defence Training Program was conducted from 5th to 6th February 2025 by Dr. Deepchand, Coach, equipping the participants with essential self-protection techniques.

To further strengthen its mission, the Women Cell inaugurated a dedicated club named 'SHE' — standing for Support, Help, Empower — with the aim of providing a continuous support system for the holistic development of women in the college.

Two surveys were conducted within the Women Cell to assess key aspects of women's health and hygiene. The first survey focused on Body Mass Index (BMI), aiming to evaluate the general health and nutritional status of the participants. This helped identify trends related to underweight, normal, overweight, or obesity among women in the cell. The second survey addressed awareness and usage of sanitary napkins, highlighting the level of knowledge, accessibility, and hygienic practices related to menstrual health. Together, these surveys provided valuable insights into the physical well-being and hygiene awareness of women, helping the cell tailor future health initiatives and awareness programs more effectively.

SC Cell And SC Scholarship

There is an SC cell in Govt. College, Kharkhara, Rewari, for the purpose of protecting the rights, addressing any kind of discrimination, promoting advocacy and representation, facilitating scholarships and financial support, counselling, guiding and giving legal Support to Scheduled Caste Students. The cell makes sure that the reservation rules pertaining to student admission is followed and it also serves as a grievance redressal cell for college staff and SC students' complaints.

There is a provision for scholarships and stipends funded by the state and central governments for SC Students to reduce the dropout rate of students. Increased Access to Education, Empowerment, Social Inclusion and Reduction of Disparities is therefore taken care off by addressing the financial challenges faced by scheduled caste and other underprivileged groups. Under the Consolidated Stipend Scheme, SC students are eligible for a yearly stipend of Rs.12,000 and Rs.2000 for books. During the Year 2022-2023, total 194 students availed the

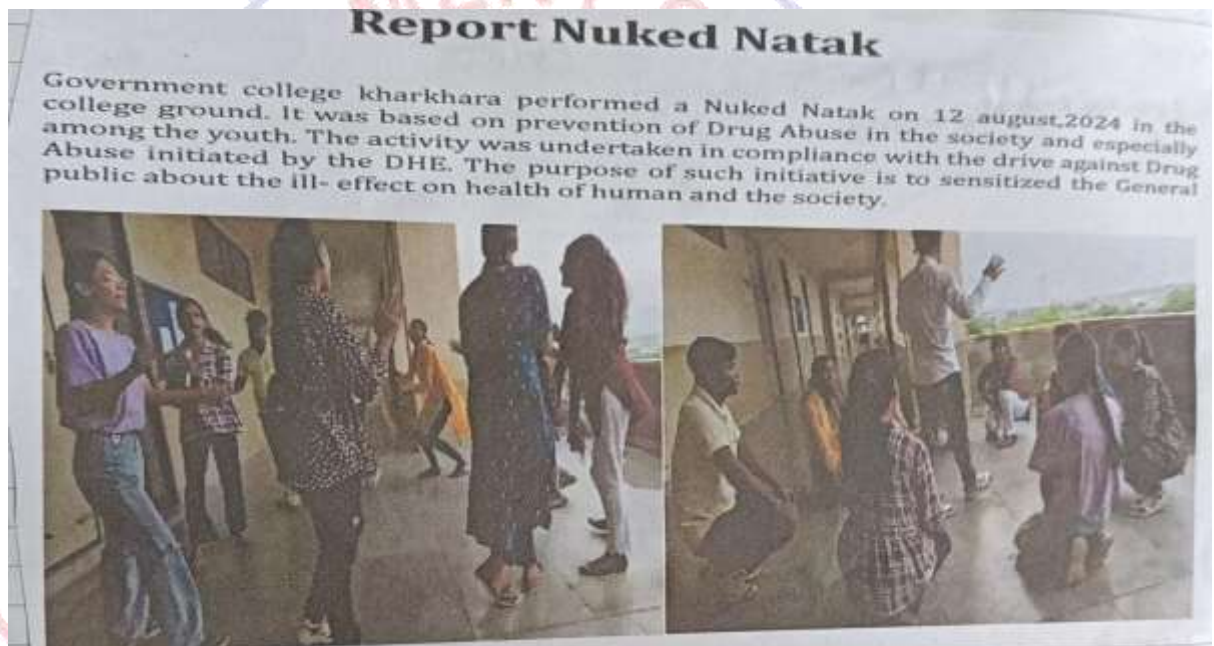
benefits of SC Scholarship. This scheme helps and contributes to a more inclusive and supportive educational environment.

7. Extension lecture and nuked Natak: (17-04-2025)

An extension lecture was delivered by college lecturer Mrs. Rajshri told about the students HIV/AIDS should cover the basics of the virus, transmission, prevention and treatment. Through the Nuked Natak students discuss the various ways HIV can be transmitted, including through unprotected sexual contact, sharing needles etc.

Earn While You Learn

EWYL, a Govt. of Haryana funded scheme is a regular practice in the college intended to benefit genuinely needy and meritorious students by engaging them in different departments/laboratories. In lieu of work done, they are paid 100 rupees per hour. This is an initiative to promote dignity of labor and self-reliance in the students. The selection process is completely transparent one, where students are judged on many factors including economic background and academic performance by a well constituted committee of senior members. In the year 2024-25, 32 students gained financial help through the scheme. Our college was granted Rs. 75000/- to be distributed among students involved. Mrs. Ekta, assistant professor of commerce is the convener of the committee.

Placement Cell

The Placement cell operates with unwavering diligence, fostering a bridge between academic and industry. It's meticulous planning and strategic initiatives ensure that our students embark on promising career journeys. The dynamics and resourceful approach of the cell not only secures placement but also empowers students with the skills and confidence

for professional success, making it an invaluable asset to our college community. Our college received grant for the upliftment of students from the Department. During the session following programs were organised from this grant.

1. A workshop was organised on 18/9/24 on career guidance by medha foundation. A workshop was organised on 12/09/2023 on CV writing and interview by Dr. Sarita Yadav, Asst. Prof., Dept. of Commerce, GC Kharkhara, Rewari
2. An extension lecture was delivered on 10/10/24 on the topic "PPT presentation and preparation" by Dr. Ramanivas, assistant professor of commerce, GC kharkhara. Rewari.
3. An extension lecture was delivered on 19/11/24 on the topic "Personality Development" by Dr. Sanjay Hooda, professor. Department of commerce, I. G. U. Meerpur.

Passport Scheme

The State Government introduced a scheme of making passports for the UG final year students in 2020-21. The decision comes as a gift from the Haryana government to students pursuing higher studies, medical facilities, business purposes, or to meet their family. The object is to ease the process to obtain a passport and encourage students to pursue higher education. For this purpose a nodal officer was assigned and trained by the passport authorities. In Government College Kharkhara, we have a committee of 4 members headed by nodal officer Sh. Satyender Singh.

For applying passport, First of all we register the students on the online portal www.passportindia.gov.in. The passport application fee of Rs. 1500/- is paid by the state government and the application is processed. It is followed by the appointment fixing by the students on the online portal and finally passports are issued to the students by the passport authority after the police verification and document verification. In our college 107 passports of the UG-final year students were successfully made till date.

Tour

A group of 47 boys students (mostly final year students) went to Agra and Vrindavan (U.P) as part of one day Educational tour on 29-Nov-2023 . They were accompanied by the tour in-charge Sh. Satyender Singh and Dr. Hari Parkash. Students visited world famous and majestic ‘Tajmahal’ in pre-lunch session and historical ‘Agra fort’ post lunch session. Students-teachers enjoyed an extensive tour to Agra, the finest example of Mughal architecture because of its many Mughal-era buildings, most notably the Taj Mahal and Red Fort of which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

While returning from Agra in the evening, we have visited ‘Prem mandir’ in the holy town Vrindavan of Uttar Pradesh. The Educational Tour to Agra Vrindavan helped the students-teacher to update their knowledge about history and acquainted them better with the rich heritage on India.

Hindi subject Society

The Hindi Subject Society of Government College Kharkhara is dedicated to nurturing love and respect for the Hindi language, which plays a vital role in uniting the cultural and linguistic diversity of India. The society strives to develop students' interest in Hindi literature, enhance their language skills, and create awareness about the importance of Hindi as both a literary and communicative medium.

Under the dedicated leadership of Dr. Sushila Lamba and Dr. Sarita, the society organizes various academic and cultural activities throughout the academic year, ensuring active student participation and holistic language development.
